Admission Information

Admission Process

The admission process in a school generally involves the following steps:

- **Enquiry & Application** – Parents or students collect or fill out an application form online or offline.
- **Eligibility Check** – Schools verify age, previous academic records, and required documents.
- **Entrance Test/Interview (if applicable)** – Some schools conduct written tests or interviews for admission.
- **Document Submission** – Required documents like birth certificate, previous school reports, and ID proofs are submitted.
- **Fee Payment** – Once selected, parents pay the admission and tuition fees to confirm enrollment.
- **Confirmation & Orientation** – The school provides an admission confirmation letter and conducts an orientation session for new students.

Required Documents

- **Birth Certificate** – Proof of age.
- **Passport-size Photographs** – Usually 4-6 copies.
- **Admission Form** – Filled and signed by parents/guardians.
- **Previous School Records** – Transfer certificate, report card, or mark sheet.
- **Address Proof** – Aadhaar card, utility bill, or rental agreement.
- **Parent's ID Proof** – Aadhaar card, passport, or any government-issued ID.
- **Medical Certificate** – Including vaccination records (if required).
- **Caste Certificate** – (If applicable for reservation benefits).
- **Income Certificate** – (If applying for fee concession or scholarships).
- **Migration Certificate** – (For students coming from a different board or state)
- SSSMID
- Photocopy of bank passbook
